Applying

Entry Requirements (All documents should be original or in the form of ratified copy)

The academic ability and potential of a student required for entry to the Islamic Theology and Religious Study program can be established from a number of ways of evidence.

1. Language Testing Requirements

Applicants must submit a score of the level of their ability in the English language. For applicants who are not native speakers in English we accept the following test scores. If you don't have language certificate, on condition that you are accepted the program, you will have to take English prepatory class in Ankara University School of Foreing Languages.

- TOEFL, a score of 550 or above on the paper test, or 213 or above on the computer test. Standardized test results more than three years old may not represent your ability.
 - IELTS, a score of 6.5 or above
 - FIRST CERTIFICATE, a score of B or above
- In either of KPDS and UDS the score of 70 or above is required.

2. High School Diploma and Transcripts

An official high school diploma and transcript are required. All applicants should provide an official English translation of their diploma and transcripts and send an explanation of the marking system, if their marking system differs from the standard letter or numerical grade systems.

It is important that you take **equivalent certificate** for your diploma from the Turkish Embassy in your home country or from the Ministry of Education in Turkey.

3. You must take any one of the exams which enables you to enter the University in your country that is equivalent to that of Turkish university entrance system. You can take ABİTUR, Sat 1, Tawjihi, GSE, International Baccalaureate, Al-Shahada al-Thanawiyya, etc.



Faculty of Theology at Ankara University has a distinguished place in the history of Islamic and religious thought in Turkey. The intellectual sources of the Faculty are rooted in the rich legacy of classical Islamic sciences advanced throughout a long-lasting and multi-cultured Islamic and Turkish history. Since its establishment in 1949, the Faculty has played an important role in the academic teaching of Islamic and religious scholarly disciplines by integrating the traditional spirit of Islamic disciplines with modern improvements of religious studies. It thus has been a distinctive character of the Faculty of Theology to accommodate traditional Islamic values and the advantages of critical thinking in religious matters.

Starting from the academic year of 2010-2011 Ankara University establishes a new department under its Faculty of Theology in order to open its gates to international students who seek to gain a well-grounded academic education in the fields of Islamic theology and religious studies. Ankara University aims at exemplifying an international community of dedicated students, scholars, and intellectuals in an intercultural milieu.

The courses will be conducted in English and there will be a preparatory English language class (one year) for the students who do not have the required level. At the end of the fourth academic year, the students will be qualified for BA degree. The students are expected to receive a comprehensive knowledge in the fields of Islamic theology and religious studies, as the courses range from the basic traditional Islamic disciplines such as Arabic language, Qur'anic exegesis (tafsir), Prophetic tradition (hadith), Islamic jurisprudence (fiqh), Islamic theology (kalam), Islamic philosophy (falsafa), Islamic mysticism (tasawwuf) and Islamic history to the modern disciplines such as philosophy of religion, the study of comparative religions, sociology of religion,



psychology of religion and religious education.
